Department of Sociology, Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University is organising two weeks inter-disciplinary capacity building programme for faculty members in Social Sciences on “Environment and Sustainable Development”. The programme will be held during October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 –October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018. It will provide a unique opportunity to the participants for a discourse, dialogue, understanding and learning the ways of conducting research in areas related to environment and sustainable development (concept note and sub-themes attached). Moreover, the course will provide intensive guidance on the use of data in social science research, research tools, and library and e-library training. The workshop will provide the participants a platform for an intensive interaction with the well-known social scientists of the country.

The faculty members from colleges, universities and research institutes interested in pursuing research in social sciences would constitute the targeted participants of this programme. A batch of about 30 participants would be selected from different parts of the country on the basis of 250 words abstract submitted by them on ‘environment and sustainable development’ along with a brief bio-data. Selected participants will be asked to develop the abstract in full paper and submit at the close of the capacity building programme. A committee will screen the full paper. Based on the selected papers, an edited book is proposed to be published from a reputed national/international publisher.

Selected participant will be paid TA as per BBAU/ICSSR rules through the shortest route. University will also provide boarding and lodging facilities. CONCEPT NOTE  
OF INTERDISCIPLINARY CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME FOR FACULTY ON  
**"ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT"**

In the 21st century, environmental issues have emerged as a focal concern in the whole world. Therefore, the academicians, planners and scholars are compelled to re-think the dominant developmental paradigm from an environmental perspective so that environmental justice can be ensued and the goal of sustainable development can be accomplished. The idea and issues involved in environment and sustainable development is too complex and therefore needs proper understanding in order to develop sensitivity towards such booming issue touching the core of human existence on this earth. The ideologies of sustainability needs everyone of us to seek ways of living that will enable us to enjoy a healthy, prosperous and just society, where people can balance between the aims of creating wealth and pursuing personal development with a respect for the natural environment and pride in our cultural heritage. It is an urgent need to bring out the central issues of sustainable development to the four enshrined in three core principles: to minimise the depletion of natural resources, to promote development without causing harm to the environment and to make use of environment friendly practices while keeping in view both biotic and abiotic environment and preserve and protect the interest of present and future generations.
