Paper submission, Selection and Publishing Process

a) Submission Acknowledgement

General Guidelines for Paper Submission

Abstract- *This should be in Italian, Font Size 12, maximum 150 words, upper margin and bottom margin, Indented left -0.3cm, right 0.3 cm*

A concise and factual abstract is required. The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the principal results and major conclusions. An abstract is often presented separate from the article, so it must be able to stand alone.

Keywords –Immediately after the abstract provide a maximum of 4-5 keywords, avoiding general and plural terms and multiple concepts (avoid, for example, ‘and’, ‘of’).

INTRODUCTION – The introduction should be written in clear and easy language which should be related to your paper and title. It is an overview of the problem; why it is important; a summary of extent work and a statement of your hypothesis or specific question to be explored. Make it readable by anyone.

Caption of table should be Capital Each Words, Bold, and Times New Roman, Font Size 10,

Source of table should be below table left side, Font size 10, Times New Roman. Color of Tables should be black and white.

Figures in the Centre of the page, and Figures Captioned should be in Capital Each Words, Bold, and Times New Roman, Font Size 10, Captioned below the figures.Description of figure should be below. The figure should be high quality. Normally, 300 dpi is required.Colour of Figures should be black and white with plane(without Margin) background with label.
