AN APPEAL

This is for kind information to all that *Parthenium hysterophorus*, commonly known as 'altamisa', carrot grass, bitter weed, star weed, white top, the "Scourge of India" and congress grass is a dominant noxious weed growing luxuriantly around the



Schools/Departments/Residential area of BBAU premises. This weed is considered to be a cause of allergic respiratory problems, contact dermatitis, etc. in human and livestock. Due to its high fecundity a single plant can produce 10,000 to 15,000 viable seeds and these seeds can disperse and germinate to cover large areas. Therefore, its eradication manually can reduce its density and lethal health impacts to the BBAU fraternity.

On the World Environment Day (5th June) all Dean/Head and authorities are requested to contribute with the available outsourcing man power to eradicate the allergic grass present around your school/departments and residential area.

The sanitation department will also contribute to eradicate the weed surrounding the Ambedkar Bhawan and Auditorium, Residential area, Hostels and Guest House of BBAU premises.
