Following are some of the suggestions and feedback provided by the alumni:


1. Many alumni suggested platform creation with Google/ web based knowledge consciousness. Moreover, e-mail/ face book/ Twitter/ Linkdin/ separate what app group methods / Research Scholar / Research gate / etc. must be ensured. Steps should be taken to attract more students into the department.
2. To conduct Offline/Online Alumni meet with current/ongoing P.G Students, Research Scholar on regular basis for effectiveness at department level.
3. Introduction to students/ Research Scholar E-resources (library facility)/ Research Scholars in academic research for training for collecting and analysis of primary data base / Data set/ Software like, SPSS/ E-Views must be ensured at department level.
4. Ensure interview/ Mock platform for students at department level for different competitive exams.
5. To conduct regular basis Seminar/ Conference/ Eco-fest at department level and invite alumni as well to participate.
6. To conduct online/offline on regular or monthly basis Debate / Lectures on current issues at department level.
7. Invite university professionals at department level for different courses at need basis.
8. Facilities and focus should be provided to help students belonging to poor background with moral support.
9. Examination related issues/ result issues/ certificate or degree related issues/ viva voce examination should be ensured timely.
10. The senior alumni who are in better position should guide the present students or recently passed out students to shape their career.
11. There must be provision for those research scholars who secured a regular job; they can continue their PhD, under 'part time' regulation.
