As per Clause 8.1 of the M.Phil./Ph.D. Regulation (2016) as amended in 2019 of the University, Total Credits of Course Work is 16.

According to the UGC letter and M.Phil./Ph.D. Regulation (2016) as amended in 2019, however, Total Credits of Course Work become $02+16=18$.

School of Pharmaceutical Science/Department as notified by the University dated 19.03.2020 has been kept in abeyance and University issued a notification no 1386/BBAU/20 dated 07.10.2020 in accordance with PCI's letter (**Annexure-S**).

To avoid delay in admissions and to attract the students from all across the country it is proposed that the university should take admissions through Central University-Common Entrance Test (CU-CET) from next Academic Session. The matter is placed for consideration and approval.

The Academic Council resolved that University may join CU-CET and the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Education/UGC from time to time in this regard may be followed.

Table Agenda No. 4: To introduce Joint Doctoral Programme between Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow and Indian Institute of Technology (B.H.U.), Varanasi.

Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow and Indian Institute of Technology (B.H.U.), Varanasi entered into MOU for academic cooperation and research. Under the umbrella of MOU, it is proposed start a Joint Doctoral Programme for promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of Research.

The MOU between Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow and Indian Institute of Technology (B.H.U.), Varanasi is placed at **Annexure-T2**.

The matter is placed for consideration and approval.

Resolution

The Academic Council approved the proposal for introducing Joint Doctoral Program with Indian Institute of Technology (B.H.U.), Varanasi. The Academic council also authorized the Vice Chancellor to constitute a committee to finalize the regulations/ordinance etc. for the Joint Doctoral Program with due consultation with Indian Institute of Technology (B.H.U.), Varanasi and approve the recommendations of the committee on behalf of Academic Council to expedite the implementation of the same.

Table Agenda No. 5: To consider the matter of increase the intake of students in B.Tech. (Civil Engineering), B.Tech. (Computer Engineering), B.Tech. (Mechanical & Automobile Engineering), B.Tech. (Electrical Engineering) and B.Tech. (Electronics & Communication Engineering) courses from present seats 40 to 60 seats in the University Institute of Engineering & Technology (UIET) of the University for the academic session 2021-22.

The proposal of Deputy Director, UIET dated 29.10.2020 is placed at **Annexure – T3** for kind consideration and approval.

Academic Council resolved to approve the same subject to the fulfillment of the requirement (Space, Lab and conducting of the classes).

Table Agenda No. 6: To consider the case of extension of Ph.D. course of Shri Ajay Pathak in the Department of Political Science over

and above the maximum time period (i.e. 5 years 6 months) submitted by Department of Political Science of the University.

The facts of above case submitted by the Department are as under:-

1. Mr Ajay Pathak, took admission in the Ph.D. Programme of Department of Political Science on 21 July 2014. He is working under the supervision of Dr. Siddhartha Mukerji. He completed his six-months coursework in December 2014. One year extension was given to him from 21/7/2018 to 20/7/2019 after completing 4 years. Thereafter, the last six months extension was granted from 21/7/2019 to 20/1/2020 on production of medical certificate. After completion of last extension of 6 months the total period i.e. 5 years 6 months has expired on 20.01.2020.
2. The clause 5.5.1 pertaining to the time period of Ph.D. course of Ph.D. regulation 1999 as amended in 2013 is as under:-

“The minimum period of registration is two year from the date of declaration of result of course work. The maximum registration period for full time and part time students shall be four and five years respectively. However, the DRC/BPGS, on the recommendation of the supervisor/Co-supervisor, may grant extension in the registration period by up to two semesters (i.e. 1 year). In special circumstances the Vice-Chancellor may grant further extension of one more semester (i.e. six months) on the recommendation of Supervisor, Head of the Department and Dean of the School. However the candidate is not eligible for the University Fellowship/Scholarship during extension period. Part time candidates shall not be eligible for any scholarship/fellowship from any institution or government body during their Ph.D. programme”

3. During his Ph.D. he joined as an assistant professor in the degree college of Aligarh on 28th August 2017 for which he duly intimated the Department.
4. Mr Ajay Pathak has again applied for extension of six months beyond the last extension limit. i.e from 21/01/2020 to 20/7/2020 and then after expiry of this term again from 21/7/2020 to 20/1/2021 due to prevailing COVID-19 situation.
5. As per Ph.D. regulation, 1999 as amended in 2013 the maximum period of Shri Ajay Pathak has been expired.
6. His extension limit as per PhD regulation 1999 as amended in 2013 (applicable in his case) is over and the case may only be put before Academic Council as per clause 8 of the aforesaid regulation.
7. The clause 8 of Ph.D. regulation 1999 as amended in 2013 pertaining to difficulty is as under:

‘Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, any question, which is not covered by these Regulation, or any difficulty arising out of these Regulation, shall be dealt with by the Academic Council.

8. Forwarding/ NOC of Sh. Ajay Pathak from Degree College, Aligarh has not been not available/ submitted by Sh. Ajay Pathak.

The application/request of extension of Ph.D. of the Sh. Ajay Pathak is not forwarded by the concerned employer.

The last extension (from 21.07.2019 to 20.01.2020) was given on medical ground but the medical leave/leave of the said period (21.07.2020 to 20.01.2020) in the degree college, Aligarh has not been provided.

The matter is placed for deliberation and decision of Academic Council.

Resolution

The Academic Council resolved to refer the proposal to the committee already constituted under the Chairpersonship of Prof. Shubhini A. Saraf issued vide letter No. 1590/Estt./BBAU/19 dated 14.10.2019 for the examination of the case in accordance with rules. The Vice Chancellor is authorized to take a final decision on the recommendations of the committee.

Item No. 01: To set up Chancellor’s Chair Professorship in the University.

Item No. 02: Supernumerary seats for children of Martyred Soldiers.

Resolution

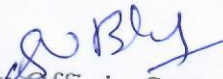
The Academic Council resolved that 5% seats of total intake may be kept for children of Martyred Soldiers as a supernumerary seat in all courses of the University.

Item No. 03: To consider the procurement and use of Anti-Plagiarism Software like Turnitin in addition to Urkund.

Resolution

The Academic Council observed that the present Anti-Plagiarism Software "Urkund" has limited database and several departments has recommended that the Anti-Plagiarism tool like "Turnitin" with more elaborate database may be procured.
