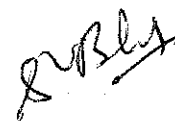

***"It was resolved that the date of submission of result of course work by the Head of the Department may be taken into account, not the date of notification of result issued by the COE office of the University".***

Further, the Academic Council resolved the following under table Agenda Item no. 3 in its 64<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council held on 30.01.2018:

***"After discussion it was resolved to follow the UGC Regulation for Ph.D. in letter & spirit".***

- ii. Regarding the resolution of agenda 2 of the Academic Reforms Committee related to pattern of the question paper for the end semester examination, the council resolved that it require more discussions and deliberations. Hence, this item has been deferred.



- iii. Regarding the resolution of agenda 3 of the Academic Reforms Committee related to deciding the weightage of continuous assessment through midterm/quiz/assignment/class text etc. and end semester exam for the final result, the council after discussion agreed in-principle that the weightage of marks of end semester examination be reduced to 50 percent from the existing 70 percent (wherever applicable) in order to enhance the weightage of various component of continuous assessment for more comprehensive evaluation of students in the semester. Therefore, council resolved that committee should revisit the agenda item for various component of continuous assessment and their weightage. After getting feedback from student and Departments, this proposal may be placed in the next Academic Council meeting.
